ELECTIVE COURSES

XVIII. Advanced Bible Research– Bib201

This is an advanced course of ministry tools using Computer Aided Bible Research (CABR). Students will learn how to use bible software to develop reference studies and more.

Prerequisite Bib101

XVIII. Ministry Techniques – Min202

This course is designed for the minister that functions in leadership and/or pastoral capacity. It includes detailed instructions on how to conduct the ceremonial services of the Church such as, the worship service, preaching, teaching, baptisms, communion, weddings, funerals and Pastoral counseling.

XIX. Music and Worship – Mis201

This course provides a historical overview of music and worship, the biblical foundations of both, and gives practical instruction on how to renew their function within the local church. A must course designed for use by music/worship leaders, choir members, instrumentalist, and the congregation.

XX. Church Educational Ministries – Ced203

This course provides a panorama of educational ministries in the local church, and presents each program's uniqueness, strengths, structure and resources.

XXI. Teaching Youth with Confidence Ced212

This course is designed to provide in-depth training for those who are teaching the Bible to the youth of today. It answers the questions how do we reach them and keep them. The overall purpose of youth education is to fulfill the biblical mandate from Christ to change lives by making disciples (Matthew 28:18-20).

XXII. Teaching Adults with Confidence Ced213

This course is designed to provide in-depth training for those who are teaching the Bible to adults. Course sessions answer the following questions: Why is it important to teach adults? What are the characteristics of adults at various stages of life? How do adults learn and how should they be taught? What are the key principles for organizing and growing adult Sunday School classes?

XXIII. The Church at Study, More Than Sunday – Ced230

This course clarifies the traditional purposes, functions, and organization of the local church program known as Sunday School. It Covers all aspects of the ministry of bringing children, youth, and adults to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ, enriching their Christian lives, and preparing them to serve Christ.

XXIV. VBS and Other Summer Ministries – Ced231

Discover new and exciting methods of educating the young to the old with non-standard church programs that will ignite the soul. Turn your VBS into an adventure.

XXV. Perspective on Church History – His201

This course covers the major periods of church history: The Ancient Church, The Medieval Church, The Reformation Church, and The Modern Church. It is designed to give Christians an overview of their spiritual heritage.

IX. Biblical Doctrines - The201

Biblical Doctrines interweaves deep Bible truths with structural threads all believers, whatever their spiritual experience, can fully grasp. Biblical Beliefs places in believers' hands a concise and valuable text of major Bible doctrines that are vital to Christian faith and practice.

X. Theology - The202

The Triune God is a popular presentation of Bible doctrine which helps meet this generation's need for confidence in God and grounding in their Christian beliefs. The individuality of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is studied and the biblical teaching of the essence of God is clearly presented.

XI. Apologetics - The203

This text is an introduction to the study of apologetics. It will take you step-by-step through the well-documented evidence. Whether a skeptic or a believer, this course will help you reach a verdict - that could very well change your life!

XII. Christian Ethics - Min201

For Christians, ethics must be rooted in the absolutes of God's Word. This course examines critical questions such as abortion, euthanasia, bioethics, human sexuality, politics, war, capital punishment, race, the arts, and the environment, from a biblical viewpoint.

XIII. Biblical Leadership – Min203

Whether you are a pastor, Christian education director, youth worker, children's director, teacher, or other ministry leader, this course will help you grow in self-perception, skills, and vision as a leader. Empower others to lead as you train, mentor, and mobilize teams for ministry.

XIV. World Views – His202

In a world where multiple "truths" abound, Christians need to be on their guard to avoid being deceived by other ways of looking at the world that directly oppose Christ and His Word. Become well informed of these other worldviews and how they differ from Christianity.

XV. Evangelism – Mis203

Evangelism is the mandate for church growth today. This course covers the biblical foundations of evangelism, conversion and regeneration, how to lead a person to a decision for Christ, age-specific techniques, team efforts, visitation, discipling new believers, and the importance of prayer.

XVI. World Missions - Mis202

This course provides an overview of missions which will inspire you to pray for, work for, and give to missions as well as compel others to do the same. While the task, methods, and means of today's missionary have changed, the underlying purpose remains the same. Discover what the local church can and should do to take an active role in God's task of global ministry. Let this discovery process ignite your heart and cause you to ask how you can become involved.
